Romans 6:1-23

Romans 6:1-23	II. Believers are no longer under the dominion of the law, but are under grace!
ntroduction: In Romans 1 Paul makes it clear that his <u>authority</u> to speak comes from <u>God</u> , and that Jesus is the <u>fulfillment</u> of the Old Testament Scriptures!	When the Spirit lives within you, your <u>relationship</u> to God's <u>Law</u> is different because you are no longer under the dominion of the <u>flesh</u> .
Romans 1:1-6:	Those who have never been <u>born</u> <u>again</u> by the Spirit will at some point <u>fall</u> <u>away</u> .
The New Testament letters are written to <u>believers</u> .	Matthew 13:18-23:
I Peter 3:9 The "YOU" toward whom God is being patient are Hiselect ALL_ of THESE will not perish, but WILL be brought to repentance, for THAT is theLord'swill!	Romans 6:12-14: "For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under <u>law</u> , but under <u>grace</u> " (vs. 14).
Romans 6:1: "Are we to <u>continue</u> in sin, that <u>grace</u> may abound?"	If Christ is <u>IN</u> you, <u>sin</u> is no longer your <u>master</u> so that you should obey the desires of the flesh.
Romans 6:2-4:	Galatians 2:20:
Paul is calling believers to "walk in <u>newness</u> of <u>life</u> " by the power of the Holy Spirit working within us. He is speaking here about the <u>baptism</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> .	You are no longer under the dominion of sin. The Law cannot <u>condemn</u> you. The <u>guilt</u> and <u>power</u> of sin has been removed from you by the blood of Jesus Christ!
Every true disciple of Jesus is united to Christ by His Spirit, and empowered to live a life of righteousness!	III. Believers are free to pursue righteousness, leading to sanctification!
. True disciples are united to Christ in His death AND in His life!	Romans 6:15-23:
Romans 6:5-11:	Paul presents the stark <u>contrast</u> between spiritual <u>death</u> and true spiritual <u>life</u> produced by the Spirit in true believers (6:4).
Believers have <u>died</u> and have been raised to life <u>spiritually</u> !	"Sanctification" is theprogressive working out of becoming more like Christ.
The transformation that takes place in every true believer is a radical, <u>inner</u> , spiritual, <u>heart</u> change becoming a NEW creation.	Hebrews 10:14; Philippians 1:6:
I Corinthians 5:17:	Romans 8:23: "We who have the first fruits of the Spirit wait eagerly for
No one becomes a new creation except for the work of the <u>Spirit</u> within	adoption as sons, the <u>redemption</u> of our <u>bodies</u> ."
them, giving them new <u>life</u> . I Corinthians 13:5:	If you have trusted in Jesus Christ for forgiveness and life, you are set free from the dominion of <u>sin</u> , and are are now free to be a " <u>slave</u> " of <u>righteousness</u> !!
