"How Shall We Then Live?"

Part 9: "As For Me and My House, We Will Serve the LORD!"



Joshua 1:1-9, 23:14-16, 24:14-15

Introduction: "Be <u>strong</u> and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the <u>LORD</u> your <u>God</u> is with you wherever you go!" - Joshua 1:9
"History" is moving along a <u>linear</u> timeline that God <u>ordained</u> before the universe was created.
It would be easy to focus only on Joshua, but ultimately, the message is about <u>Joshua's</u> <u>God</u> who was now commissioning him to lead HIS people.
God uses faithful leaders to bring His blessing to those who obey His commands.
I. God chooses leaders
This was not a " <u>chance</u> " appointment. God <u>chose</u> Joshua to lead His people into the promised land.
God chooses leaders and <u>prepares</u> and <u>equips</u> them for the purpose HE desires, and then puts them in the <u>places</u> and circumstances of His choosing.
Exodus 17:8-16, 24:13:
Numbers 14:6-9: "If the LORD <u>delights</u> in us, He will bring us into this land and <u>give</u> it to us" (vs. 8).
Numbers 27:18,22-23: "And Moses laid his hands on him (Joshua) andcommissioned him" (vs. 23).
Deuteronomy 31:7-8; Joshua 1:9:
If you want to know if a leader has been <u>chosen</u> and <u>called</u> by God, look for one thing above anything else: <u>HUMILITY</u> !!
Philippians 2:5-8:

God chooses leaders to display HISpower andglory!
Matthew 20:25-28:
I Corinthians 2:3-5: "I was with you in <u>weakness</u> and <u>fear</u> so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men, but in the <u>power</u> of <u>GOD</u> !"
II. God rewards faithfulness
<u>Satan</u> likes to <u>attack</u> God's leaders but God rewards faithfulness.
Joshua 2 - 12:
"Faithfulness" is not measured only in what you do forpeople, but in what you do for theGod youserve!
Joshua 8:30-35:
Joshua 23:1-11,14: " you know in your <u>hearts</u> and <u>souls</u> that not one word has <u>failed</u> of all the good things that the LORD your God <u>promised</u> concerning you" (vs. 14).
Joshua 24:13-15:
III. God blesses obedience
God's chosen leaders will be used by God to teach His people the way of life in God's kingdom: Lovingobedience to the God whosaved them to be His own!
Romans 12:1-2: " that you may discern what is the <u>will</u> of <u>God</u> , what is good and acceptable and perfect" (vs. 2).
Joshua 24:16-24:
The call to obedience has gotten lost and <u>replaced</u> by the declaration of God's " <u>love</u> " for all, regardless of what they believe or how they live.
Beware of leaders who fail to call you to <u>confession</u> of sin, to <u>repentance</u> and to heartfelt, loving <u>obedience</u> to the One who saves those who believe.
Ephesians 4:11-16:
