
## "The Testimony Every True Believer Has in Their Heart"



## I John 5:10-13

changes are good MOST changes are hard!
We need to focus our attention not on what has changed, or what is changing, or what may change, bur rather, on what isNOT changing and on wha willNEVER change.
Hebrews 6:13-19:
The sure and certain hope that is set before us is that the <u>blood</u> of Jesus covers our sins, and His <u>reign</u> at the Father's right hand results in <u>eternal</u> <u>life</u> for all who believe.
I John 5:6-9:
Through Jesus' <u>baptism</u> and <u>crucifixion</u> God testifies by His <u>Spirit</u> that Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, God's anointed King.
God has given eternal life to all who believe in the name of His Son, Jesus Christ!
II Corinthians 4:16-18:
I. YOU need to have a testimony!
Many people live in a continual state of spiritual <u>doubt</u> , <u>anxiety</u> and <u>fear</u> , instead of trusting God for today and tomorrow.
I John 5:10: " Whoever does <u>NOT</u> believe God has made Him a <u>liar</u> ."
I John 5:11-13:
John is writing to <u>believers</u> , and is saying that the Holy Spirit produces an <u>inner</u> testimony that comes from God.
Your calling is to testify to others about God and about the <u>Savior</u> He sent to <u>save</u> us from His just <u>judgment</u> against our sins.
Ephesians 2:1-6:

## I John 5:13:

II. Every true believer has the SAME testimony!
Doubt is the devil's playground! It is the opposite of faith The two cannot coexist.
If you are <u>unsure</u> about God and His promises, will you testify that His Spirit now lives within you and that your <u>faith</u> is the <u>victory</u> that overcomes the world??
I John 5:10-12:
Here is your testimony: "God has <u>GIVEN</u> ME eternal life, and this life is in His <u>SON</u> !"
Romans 6:23:
Ephesians 2:8-9:
If the only difference between a believer and an unbeliever is that one <a href="mailto:chose">chose</a> to believe and the other didn't, then who gets the <a href="mailto:credit">credit</a> ?? Who gets the <a href="mailto:glory">glory</a> ????
Either God has <u>given</u> us eternal life OR He has only made it <u>possible</u> and the rest is up to us.
III. Our testimony is based on and points to GOD's work!
Romans 5:8, 8:7-8:
Those without the Spirit of God are spiritually <u>dead</u> , and totally and utterly <u>incapable</u> of knowing God or believing in Jesus.
The <u>Gospel</u> is the power of God to produce a new heart, mind and will that is now <u>empowered</u> and <u>enabled</u> to believe to receive God's gift of grace!
John 1:12-13:
You know you are born again when by an act of your new heart, mind and will you <u>choose</u> to <u>believe</u> in Jesus as your Savior and Lord.
Revelation 3:19-22
The Gospel is this:GOD did and doeseverything necessary for our salvation!!
