Part 5: "The New Heaven and the New Earth"



Revelation 21-22; Isaiah 65:17-19, 66:22-24; II Peter 3:1-13

Introduction: " and the <u>tree</u> of <u>life</u> was in the midst of the Garden" – Genesis 2:9
Genesis 3:23-24:
"Revelation" = "apocalypse" = uncovering, revealing.
God will keep His promise to create a new heaven and a new earth, and all who come to Him through Jesus Christ will live with Him in this new world, to praise and serve Him FOREVER!!
Genesis 3:15:
Isaiah 65:17, 66:22: "Behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the <u>former</u> things shall not be <u>remembered</u> " (Isaiah 65:17).
You need to see into <u>eternity</u> and know that you are here to <u>serve</u> the King who is now reigning at the Father's right hand!
I. Now the dwelling of God is with man
Revelation 21:1:
Revelation 20:11: "Then I saw a great white <u>throne</u> and Him who was seated on it. From His presence earth and sky <u>fled</u> <u>away</u> "
Isaiah 24:1,19-20:
II Peter 3:10-13:
It appears that God is describing the <u>destruction</u> of this planet and the <u>creation</u> of a new planet.
Revelation 21:2-4:
While <u>mankind</u> attempts to establish this own "new world order" today, THIS is <u>GOD's</u> "new world order"!!!
Revelation 21:5-8:

The separation of believers from unbelievers is! (Matt. 25:46)
II. The New Jerusalem the "Bride, the wife of the Lamb"
Revelation 21:9:
As God destroys evil and all His enemies, THIS is His goal: to <u>fulfill</u> His <u>promises</u> to His people!
Revelation 21:10-21:
Hebrews 12:22-24:
The "new Jerusalem" includes the dwelling-place ofGOD, the host of angels around the throne, theChurch and the remnant from Israel.
What John is attempting to describe in <u>human</u> words is the <u>eternal</u> home of God and His people.
Revelation 21:22-27:
All of this points to the <u>wisdom</u> , <u>power</u> and <u>majesty</u> of God, our Creator, our Redeemer, our Savior, our Lord, our KING!!!
III. The River of Life
Revelation 22:1-5:
The "tree of life," from which Adam and Eve were <u>banished</u> , NOW stands in the <u>middle</u> of the great city, the new Jerusalem!
In the new heaven and earth we will "eat of the tree of life," and we will receive from God the power to <u>sustain</u> the <u>perfection</u> in which we will be living.
Revelation 22:6: "These words are <u>trustworthy</u> and <u>true</u> "
IV. The Invitation
Revelation 22:7-21:
The "last days," from GOD's perspective, began when Jesus went to the <u>cross</u> , rose from the dead and <u>ascended</u> into heaven.
II Peter 3:3-4,8,10-13: "According to His <u>promise</u> , WE are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which <u>righteousness</u> dwells!" (vs. 13).
