Introduction: What is idolatry?

Colossians 3:5

Covetousness is an "inappropriate desire for more."

Idolatry is when we <u>treasure</u>, <u>trust</u>, or <u>thirst</u> for something or someone more than God.

Psalm 115:4-8

Our fallen tendency is to abandon faithfulness to God for the worship of idols.

Psalm 106:34-39

I. Faithfulness in One <u>Generation</u> Does Not <u>Guarantee</u> Faithfulness in the Next <u>Generation</u>

Three reasons why God did not drive out the remaining Canaanites...

- 1. It was to <u>punish</u> His people for not obeying; 2:3, 21
- 2. It was to <u>prepare</u> the next generations for war; 3:2
- 3. It was to <u>prove</u> the next generations, to see if they would obey the Lord or not; 2:22; 3:1, 4

The name "Baal" was used for the weather/storm god in the Canaanite religion.

The name "Ashtaroth" designated a female goddess, and was worshipped as the goddess of <u>love</u>.
