The Two Sins of Eli's Sons:

- 1. They <u>despised</u> the offering of the LORD.
- 2. They had immoral relations with the women who tended the worship center.

Key Truth: God's Word is His gracious gift to a world languishing in the black darkness of sin.

I. God Judges People through Silence

In the days of Eli it was rare because God was not <u>speaking</u> frequently. In our day it can be rare because of problems on the <u>receiving</u> end.

II. God Blesses People through Speaking

The underlying <u>assumption</u> of needing to hear the voice of God, apart from Scripture, for direction and guidance is that the Bible is not <u>sufficient</u> to guide you.

III. We Serve God by **Speaking** His Word

God wanted Samuel to have to speak these difficult words to Eli.
